



## FORGED IN STEEL

Bramall Lane first opened its doors for business in 1855 when it staged a cricket game between "the 11 and the 22".

It held its first football match, a fundraiser for the Lancashire Mills Distress Fund on December 29th 1862 and, over the course of its existence, has staged in the region of 16 different sports within its famous boundaries.

In 1867, it held the first ever football cup final, when Hallam FC beat Norfolk to win the Youdan Cup. In 1878 the first floodlit game of football in the world was held here. In 1883 one of the first England v Scotland games outside of London or Glasgow was staged and in 1889 Sheffield's first FA Cup Semi Final took place between PNE and WBA - the record crowd and gate receipts of over £500 led to the formation of Sheffield United FC on March 22nd of that year.

It is one of only two venues in the country to have staged Ashes Test Cricket and the FA Cup Final - the other being the Oval. It was also the stadium that saw the Blades' Brian Deane score the Premier League's first ever goal v Manchester United in 1992.


Cricket left the Lane in 1973 and the ground became a four sided, purely football stadium for the first time in its history.

Its record crowd was for the FA Cup 5th Round game v Leeds United in 1936 when the official crowd was recorded as 68,500 - today it is a 33,000 all seater stadium with Premier League facilities

## SPARKLING & CHAMPAGNE

- 1 Bel Star Prosecco DOC NV 26.00**  
(Veneto, Italy) **11%**  
Soft, fruity and refreshing sparkling wine with citrus, pear and floral flavours and aromas.
- 2 Pannier Brut NV 45.00**  
(Champagne, France) **11%**  
A fresh and harmonious wine which combines subtle notes of brioche, pastries and acacia flowers with fresh fruit aromas.

## WHITE

- 3 La Maglia Rosa, Pinot Grigio 20.00**  
(Veneto, Italy) **11.5%**  
A well-rounded wine with flavours of white fruits and delicate floral notes. Dry and crisp with an elegant, light body.
- 4 Domaine des Marronnier, Chablis 33.00**  
(Burgundy, France) **12.5%**  
This brilliant medium-bodied Chablis has pure aromas and flavours of green apples, lemons and limes, with just a whisper of stony minerality.
- 5 Acacia Tree, Chenin Blanc 19.00**  
(Western Cape, South Africa) **13%**  
This easy-drinking wine has fresh citrus and peach flavours with a zippy, refreshing finish.
- 6 San Abello, Sauvignon Blanc 22.00**  
(Central Valley, Chile) **12%**  
This dry and crisp wine has fresh tropical fruit aromas and flavours of gooseberry and lime with grassy, herbaceous notes.
- 7 Tuffolo, Cortese 24.00**  
(Peirmonate, Italy) **12%**  
A delicate white wine, with citrus fruit flavours, and a clean, fresh finish.

## ROSÉ

- 8 Wandering Bear, Rosé 21.00**  
(Western Cape, South Africa) **11%**  
Notes of black cherry on the nose, with a palate chocked full of raspberry and watermelon fruit flavours. It's a juicy wine, yet light and refreshing on the finish.
- 9 La Maglia Rosa, Pinot Grigio Blush 23.00**  
(Veneto, Italy) **11.5%**  
An easy-drinking blush, with Bright summer fruits, delicate floral notes and a crisp acidity

## RED

- 10 Castillo Clavijo, Rioja Crianza 24.50**  
(Rioja, Spain) **12.5%**  
Aged for 12 to 18 months in American and French oak casks, it shows bright red berry fruit balanced with vanilla and spice to add richness and body.
- 11 Alto Bajo, Merlot 20.00**  
(Central Valley, Chile) **12%**  
Intense aromas and flavours of ripe plums, sweet spices, coffee, chocolate and delicate smoky notes. This wine has a soft and smooth texture.
- 12 Acacia Tree, Pinotage 19.00**  
(Western Cape, South Africa) **13.5%**  
A soft, easy-drinking red wine, with flavours of blackcurrants, cherries and plums.
- 13 Chateau La Croix Ferrandat 33.00**  
(St-Emilion, France) **14%**  
Ripe and rounded with plum, bramble jelly and blackcurrant fruit. Medium to full bodied with soft tannins and a long, fresh finish.
- 14 Argentio, Malbec 23.00**  
(Medoza, Argentina) **13.5%**  
This medium-bodied red wine has aromas and flavours of plums, black cherries and hints of violet. It has a velvety smooth texture and a soft lingering finish.
